By simplifying the management of your communications system, the Millennium Assistant empowers your system administrators to make user changes without dealer assistance, giving you control over administrative man-hours and costs.


Moves, Adds, and Changes

Designed with end-user efficiency in mind, the Millennium Assistant features an intuitive graphical user interface (GUI) depicting specific Millennium, 3100, and single line telephones as well as the Orbit wireless handset. Assistant gives a visual indication of which buttons are programmed or available. Features include:

- Simple "drag and drop" button programming
- Adding and deleting telephones at a specific location with one click of the toolbar
- Easy-to-read templates of all Millennium telephone types


Scheduler

After the desired changes are made within the Assistant, the Scheduler utility provides the option of applying the changes to your Millennium system immediately, at a scheduled off-peak time and date, or at specific recurring intervals – whatever fits your communication needs.




Assistant's graphical interface makes telephone programming quick and easy.

User Guides

The Assistant allows you to print a customized user guide specific to each user location to export the easy-to-read information as an e-mail or to save the file to a disk. The user guide identifies and gives a brief description of all the button features on a particular telephone.

Company Directory

The Assistant also allows you to print a company directory that includes all extensions or only those you choose to list. You can export the directory as a file that you can view or print in another application or attach to an email message. The Assistant's Company Directory feature helps administrators manage their telephone directories more efficiently.
